New grants scheme for Bletchley and Fenny Stratford businesses



Milton Keynes City Council has launched grant schemes for business owners and aspiring entrepreneurs in Bletchley and Fenny Stratford.

Start-ups can apply for up to £2,500 and existing business owners for up to £5,000. The initiative is co-funded by the City Council and the Bletchley and Fenny Stratford Town Deal and it supports the city council's vision to drive business growth and create jobs for local people.

Start-ups will need to prove that they have a business ready to be launched in Bletchley and Fenny Stratford, or have been operating for three years or less and need support to develop. The grant can be used for marketing, branding, training, business planning, financial



Existing businesses must demonstrate an ambition to grow by introducing new products or services, or by scaling up their current offer. The grant could be used to buy new equipment, cover consultancy costs, staff training, rebranding, software development or repairs and maintenance of premises.

Firms need to have been operating for a minimum of three years in Bletchley and Fenny Stratford.

The grant scheme is now live and will run until March 2025 or whilst funds are available. Further information and details on how to apply are available on the <u>Groundbreaking Bletchley and Fenny Stratford website</u>.

Public realm improvements consultation



The summer consultations have finished on the public realm improvements for Queensway and Aylesbury Street, and on the works on Saxon Street to create an accessible and inspiring gateway into the town centre.

The Town Deal team delivered 12 consultation events between 3 August – 22 September, giving the public and key stakeholders the opportunity to have their say on the emerging designs. We gathered additional valuable feedback via our online Commonplace platform and from residents who filled out paper questionnaires. Thank you all for your contributions.

Our next steps include sharing a response to your feedback in the form of a, 'you said, we listened and considered' report. After the report, detailed designs will be prepared, with final designs shared with you in Spring 2025. Construction is expected to start in Summer 2025.



New Business Narrative for Bletchley and Fenny Stratford



The redevelopment of the former Sainsbury's site is underway with 70% of the building demolished. The work is due to be completed by 15 November 2024.

This site and the Brunel Centre, forms part of our ambitious plans to create a modern mixed-use development that caters for the future needs of Bletchley.
