Coming soon to Aylesbury Street




It's going to be a June start for the public realm improvements on Aylesbury Street.

The works include new planting, street, furniture, signage, and safety improvements to road crossings at: Denmark Street, Eden Crescent, George Street and Church Street. There will also be upgrades made to the two crossings on Aylesbury Street.

Our public realm project will take approximately six to eight weeks to complete. We'll let you know the exact dates when the work will start. Meanwhile the map below shows the planned diversion route for buses that would normally use Aylesbury Street.

Bletchley and Fenny Stratford Town Council will be watering and maintaining the plants until the planters are replaced with a more permanent solution as part of the public realm improvement works on Queensway.
